


School Development Plan – Outcome

- Targeted Intervention Tracking sheet

- Teacher Perception Survey
- Teacher Confidence in differentiation (Writing and Numeracy)
- Collection of student writing samples
- Student interviews regarding next steps





School Development Plan – Learning Excellence Actions

- Utilize consistent specific and timely formative assessment practices to move student learning forward
- Build share and use writing exemplars to enrich student understanding of success criteria
- Utilize high impact strategies to explicitly teach vocabulary and number sense.
- Provide opportunities for student differentiation through multiple entry points
- Through a centers approach, implement targeted numeracy interventions





School Development Plan – Well-Being Actions

- Celebrate and use mistakes for opportunities for learning
- Activate students as owners of learning through goal setting, self assessment and reflection
- Provide feedback that moves learning forward
- Create a culture that encourages risk taking

- At least 75 per cent of budgeted funds covers staffing and the remaining portion covers instructional and operational supplies.
